

To whom it may concern,

We have classified the wines, brandys and liquors listed below in suitable or not suitable for vegetarians following the guidelines of the Vegetarian Society of Great Britain.

The use of the following clarifying agents are considered non suitable for vegetarians:

- gelatine
- egg white (usually from battery hens, including egg albumen),
- isinglass (from the swim bladder of the sturgeon)
- chitin which is derived from crushed lobster or crab shells

These clarifying agents are used respecting the COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) No 1493/1999, of 17 May 1999, on the common organisation of the market in wine and EC No 1622/2000, of 24 July 2000.
